Plans are underway as of this writing to increase the number of mooring balls from two to four this year. However, members are reminded to please accommodate other boats both at the dock and on the mooring balls by rafting together if and when required. Jemmett's Landing is for all of us to enjoy! Rafting is a wonderful way for you to get to know your fellow sailors as well.

You will quickly see that there is a great deal of stacked firewood now available. Please do bring your own dry kindling and newspaper to start your bonfire, and ensure that it is properly and fully extinguished before your depart! Finally, all users of Jemmett's Landing are requested to please remove of all of their garbage when departing.
