# **Notice of Race**

# Kingston Yacht Club Canadian 49er, 49erFX, 29er Championship July 31- August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015

You are cordially invited to attend the 2015 Canadian 49er, 49erFX and 29er Championship being held at Kingston Yacht Club, July 31<sup>st</sup> to August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015. Kingston Yacht Club is located at 1 Maitland St., just west of downtown Kingston at the eastern end of Lake Ontario.

### 1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RSS).

1.2. The Organizing Authority for this regatta is the Kingston Yacht Club (KYC) in conjunction with the Canadian 49er, 49erFX and 29er Associations.

1.3. The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association (CYA) will apply.

1.4. The Rules and Specifications of the International 49er, International 49erFX and the International 29er Class will apply.

### 2. ADVERTISING

2.1. Boats and competitors shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20, Advertising Code. Competing boats may be required to display advertising of the Event Sponsor as provided by the Organizing Authority.

## **3. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY**

3.1. The regatta is open to 49er, 49er, FX and 29ers.

3.2. Participants must be members of their respective Class Associations.

3.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing registration (registration can be done online at

kingstonyachtclub.com/29erchampionships, or by mail) and getting the required entry fee to the Kingston Yacht Club by end of the day, **July 10/15**. Late entries will be accepted but are subject to a **late fee of \$75**.

### 4. FEES

4.1. If received by July 10<sup>th</sup>, the entry fee is \$200 and includes; draw prizes, t shirts and Saturday night dinner.

Cheques should be payable to: The Kingston Yacht Club.

4.2. Entries received after July 10<sup>th</sup> would make the entry fee \$275 per boat (late fee is \$75).

### **5. SCHEDULE for REGATTA**

Sunday August 2<sup>nd</sup>
10:30 Warning Gun 1<sup>st</sup> race of the day
16:00 Prize Giving
5.2 A maximum of twelve (12) races will be sailed over the three days.
5.3 No warning signal will be made after 1500 on Sunday August 2<sup>nd</sup>.

#### 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Sailing Instructions will be posted on the southwest window of the clubhouse, with paper copies available for competitors at registration.

# 7. COACHES and COACH BOATS:

There will be a coaching fee of \$35.00 per coach that will provide coaches with a dinner and a place to keep their boats. Coaches must register with the regatta organizers when they arrive at KYC. Coaches will be issued a numbered flag which they must display while in the racing area and are expected to monitor the safety channel on their VHF radios and be available to assist in an emergency.

### 8. VENUE

8.1. Racing will take place southwest of KYC.

#### 9. SCORING

9.1. The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2, will be used except as modified below.

9.2. Three races will constitute a series.

9.3. There will be one throw out when five or more races are completed. It is planned to have 4 races a day. There will be a maximum of 12 races.

#### **10. PRIZES & TROPHIES**

10.1 Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 crews overall in the 49er, 49erFX fleets and top 5 for the 29er fleet.

### **11. DISCLAIMER OF RESPONSBILITY**

11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

### **12. INSURANCE**

12.1 Each participant shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$2,000,000 CAD.

### **13.FURTHER INFORMATION**

13.1 Competitors and their immediate families are welcome to use the club facilities during the regatta. 13.2. Camping will NOT be permitted on the Club Property.
