1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RSS).
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority for this regatta is The Kingston Yacht Club (KYC) in conjunction with the Canadian 505 Association.
- 1.3. The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association (CYA) will apply.
- 1.4. The Rules and Specifications of the International 505 Class will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is only open to 505s.
- 2.2. Participants must be members of their National 505 Association.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it with the required entry fee to the Kingston Yacht Club by June 12/09. Late entries will be accepted but are subject to a late fee of \$50.

3. FEES

- 3.1. If received by June 12th, the entry fee is \$150 (Cdn.) or \$125 (US) and includes; draw prizes, t shirts, 2 dinners and free beer. Cheques should be payable to: The Kingston Yacht Club. Visa or Mastercard will be accepted if you wish to phone your entry into the office and then follow up your call by sending your entry form by fax or mail.
- 3.2. **Entries received after June 12th will be subject to a late fee of \$50 per boat.**

- 4.2 A maximum of nine (9) races will be sailed over the three days.
- 4.3 No warning signal will be made after 1500 on Sunday July 5th.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Sailing Instructions will be posted on the southwest window of the clubhouse, with paper copies available for competitors at registration.

6. VENUE

6.1. Racing will take place southwest of KYC.

7. SCORING

7.1. The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2, will be used except as modified below.

7.2. Three races will constitute a series.

7.3. There will be one throw out when four or more races are completed. When 8 or more races are completed there will be two throw outs. There will be a maximum of 9 races.

8. PRIZES & TROPHIES

8.1 Trophies will be awarded to the top 7 crews overall.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 for the event.

11.FURTHER INFORMATION

11.1 Competitors and their immediate families are welcome to use the club facilities during the regatta.

11.2. Camping will NOT be permitted on the Club Property.
